<ul> <li>Includes Old Testament saints, all believers who died before/after the death &amp; resurrection of Jesus (1Th 4:14), the Raptured (1Th 4:17), Tribulation martyrs (Rev 20:4), and those who became believers during the Tribulation</li> </ul>
